Refrain from including any information that could be construed as a mailing address by the high speed optical reader.

This area is for the addressing of your postcards. The addressing is read by automated machines at the post office and their rules are very strict. How much area you have for things other than the address depends on how many lines the address has and the longest line of the address. You should work from the lower right hand corner of the yellow box in figuring out how much space is needed for your addressing and then create your design based on the largest address area needed.
